Inspired Child's programs focus on the first five years of children's lives, the stage when 90% of our brains develop. It's crucial to prioritize this early stage of development when foundations for learning are established.

# The arts promote brain development and learning.


Research has proven that engaging in arts activities stimulates brain growth, learning, and social-emotional development.

Our programs are specifically designed to create spaces for creativity and socialization, which stimulate the neural connections necessary for learning and human relationships.

Music, dance, theater, and visual arts promote active exploration of the environment through individual and group creative processes and encourage human connections—the foundation for learning.

Inspired Child has been supporting and improving early childhood education in Washington, DC since 1994, and we are a proud six-time recipient of the Mayor's Award for Outstanding Work in Early Childhood Education.

Every year Inspired Child:

- Brings direct programs to over 1,000 children
- Provides professional development to over 1,000 teachers
- Distributes over 2,500 books



Inspired Child partners with DC public schools, charter schools, and community-based child development centers to bring multi-week arts-based classroom residencies to early learners. Our team of professional artists use music, movement, and visual arts to support classroom learning standards and promote cognitive and social-emotional development through specialized programs designed for infants, toddlers, and preschool students.





Through our book donation program, Reading For Life<sup>™</sup>, Inspired Child provides thousands of books to stock classrooms and home libraries. At the end of each residency, every child receives a backpack full of books to take home; for some children, these are the first books they own.

We believe that something as simple as a backpack filled with books not only inspires enthusiasm for reading but also sends a powerful message to the children that they matter and that people care about their future.

## FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

To ensure that learning continues at home, Inspired Child develops parent workshops, family events, and educational materials that encourage parents to engage their children in arts-based learning outside of the classroom.

Every year we send thousands of books to children's homes, with tips for parents on how to inspire a lifelong love of reading:

#### snuggle

Find a comfortable, quiet spot to read together.

#### ask questions

As you read, stop to ask "What do you think might happen next?"

#### take turns

Let your child "read" to you. Children love to make up stories.

#### explore

Visit your local library to discover new books and let your child select the books they take home.

#### every day

Read to your child every day, especially at bedtime.

#### remember

A child is never too young for reading together!



Our workshops for early childhood educators provide teachers with the skills they need to effectively integrate the arts into achieving classroom learning goals. Inspired Child is certified as a professional development provider by DC's Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE), and teachers earn credit hours they can use toward their professional recertification. The content of the workshops aligns with the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and Common Core standards.
